



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

Federal Interagency Working Group on Limited English Proficiency

Do you have trouble with English? Are you unable to speak, read, write, or understand English well? If so, you are Limited English Proficient (LEP).

Federal agencies and organizations that get money from the federal government have to take reasonable steps to help people who have trouble with English.

Sometimes, when a government agency or an organization does not help you because you are LEP, they violate the law. This is called National Origin Discrimination.

"If you are mistreated because you are LEP, it may be National Origin Discrimination."

EXAMPLES of National Origin Discrimination:

EXAMPLES of Good Practices:



There is a Federal law that protects your civil rights. The law is called Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

1 You and many people who live in your area speak Vietnamese and often go to the hospital for emergency care. The hospital does not understand these LEP patients. Most Vietnamese patients do not understand what the hospital tells them about their medical care.

2 You call 911 to report a crime. The operator does not understand you and cannot help you.

3 Your child's school sends important information or a notice to you in English. The school knows you speak only Spanish. The school refuses to provide the information to you in Spanish and suggests instead that your child interpret the information for you.


1 The hospital knows that many people who cannot understand English and speak Vietnamese live in the area. The hospital has interpreters who are ready and able to help you when you go to the hospital for emergency care.

2 You call 911 to report a crime. The operator connects you quickly to an interpreter who helps you.

3 Your child's school has many Spanish-speaking parents. The school knows you speak only Spanish. You should receive the important information or notice in Spanish.

4 You try to apply for food stamps. The application is in English. You do not understand the application. The Food Stamp office workers tell you to come back with your own interpreter.

4 The food stamp office has an interpreter, so contacts a telephone interpreter, to help you. An application in your language is given to you.

إن من واجبات الوكالات الحكومية الفدرالية والمنظمات التي تتلقى الدعم المالي من الحكومة الفدرالية أن تقوم بخطوات مناسبة لمساعدة الأشخاص ذوي المهارات المحدودة في فهم اللغة الإنجليزية.

إن أية وكالة أو منظمة حكومية لا تقوم أحياناً بمساعدتك بسبب مهاراتك المحدودة في فهم اللغة الإنجليزية أمر يجعلها تخالف قانون «التمييز بسبب الهوية الأصلية».

إن إساءة معاملتك بسبب مهارتك المحدودة في اللغة الإنجليزية قد يعد تمييزاً بهويته الأصلية.

١ تعرف إدارة المستشفى أن الكثيرين من سكان المنطقة هم من الذين يتحدثون الضيائية ولا يستطيعون فهم اللغة الإنجليزية. لهذا تقوم المستشفى بتوفير مترجمين شقويين جاهزين وقادرين على مساعدتك حينما تضطر للذهاب إلى المستشفى في الحالات الطارئة.

٢ إذا اتصلت برقم الطوارئ ٩١١ للإبلاغ عن جريمة ما، على عاملة الهاتف تحويل مكالمتك بسرعة إلى مترجم يساعدك.

٣ لدى مدرسة طفلك قائمة بالكثير من أولياء الأمور الذين يتكلمون الأسبانية، وهي تعلم أنك لا تتحدث سوى الأسبانية. لذا عليها أن تبحث الملاحظات أو المعلومات المهمة اليك باللغة الأسبانية.


٤ لدى مكتب بطاقات الغذاء المجاني مترجم، أو على المكتب الاتصال هاتفياً بمترجم يساعدك لكي يتم بالتالي إعطائك طلباً يلفتك.

١ الكثيرون من الذين يسكنون في منطقتك هم من المتحدثين باللغة العربية، وغالباً ما يضطرون للذهاب إلى المستشفى للحصول على العناية الطارئة، حيث لا يتحدث اللغة العربية أي فرد من أفراد الطاقم الطبي في قسم الطوارئ. إن طاقم المستشفى لا يستطيع فهم ما يقوله هؤلاء المرضى ذوي المهارات المحدودة في اللغة الإنجليزية، كما أن معظم هؤلاء المرضى العرب لا يفهمون ما تقوله المستشفى لهم عن حالتهم الطبية.

٢ إذا اتصلت برقم الطوارئ ٩١١ للإبلاغ عن جريمة ما، لن تفهم عاملة الهاتف ما تقول ولن تتمكن بالتالي من مساعدتك.

٣ تقوم مدرسة طفلك بإرسال ملاحظات أو معلومات مهمة إليك باللغة الإنجليزية. إنها ترفض إرسال المعلومات إليك باللغة الأسبانية رغم معرفتها أنك لا تتحدث سوى الأسبانية، وتقترح عوضاً عن ذلك أن يقوم طفلك بترجمتها لك.

٤ لدى محاولتك تقديم طلب للحصول على بطاقات أو قسائم الغذاء المجاني، لا يمكنك ذلك، لأن ملء الطلب يجب أن يتم باللغة الإنجليزية. لذا يطلب منك موظفو مكتب بطاقات الغذاء أن تعود وممكن مترجمك الخاص بك.






