## MENTAL HEALTH COURT (MHC) PROCESS Sept. 2009

<u>Case Referred to MHC for Look-See/Courtesy Hearing:</u> May occur at any stage of a case; referral may come from police, prosecutor, defense, jail, case manager, family

Court Monitor/Liaison decides with input from MHC team members (prosecutor and defense), interviewing defendant and any current treatment providers: Is defendant eligible for MHC?

- 1. Axis I Diagnosis?
- 2. Amenable & Defendant wants MHC Probation
- 3. Defendant's drug or alcohol issues do not outweigh mental health issues

Defendant placed on MHC Conditions of Release (COR); monitored by Court Monitor with status hearings

Defendant found eligible by Court Monitor -AND- defendant wants case in MHC

Opts in to MHC (Plead Guilty, Enter Diversion or Probation Transferred into MHC

MHC Conditions of Sentence ordered and MHC Probation Officer assigned (Probation supervision for up to 2 years)

Defendant found not eligible by Court Monitor

OR- defendant

does not want case in MHC

Case sent back to mainstream / traditional court for next hearing. Defendant may want a trial or plead guilty. If plead or found guilty the court has the authority to order non-MHC probation and expect the defendant to be in treatment, report to a Probation Officer and attend Review Hearings

Frequent appointments with Probation and Review Hearings to monitor compliance and provide structure. Court uses positive reinforcement and graduated sanctions to gain compliance

Revocation may occur if not compliant
