 - Residents most likely to speak English poorly:
 - Central or South America (46%)
 - ✓ Former USSR (30%)
 - ✓ Asia (24%)
- ${\color{red} \bullet}$ Employment rates similar to total population (5.3% vs. 5.4%)
 - · Unemployment highest among:
 - ✓ Africa (11.1%)
 - ✓ Middle East (7.7%)
 - ✓ Former USSR (7.7%)


SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS OF FOREIGN BORN


- o Poverty Status

 Middle East (11%)




REFUGEE ARRIVALS BY INITIAL STATE OF RESIDENCE: FFY 2009







