Who takes an LTC test?

- To-be:
 - Interpreters
 - Translators
 - New requirement:
 - 18+
 - High School diploma/GED/equivalent
- DSHS Employees
- Licensed Agency Personnel (LAPL)

What languages does LTC test?

- Certified languages
 - Cambodian, Chinese-Cantonese, Chinese-Mandarin, Korean, Laotian, Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese
- Screened Languages
 - Any other language, other than those above

Authorizations and Certifications

- Certifications
 - Medical Interpreter
 - Social Services Interpreter
 - Translator
 - Employee/LAPL
- Authorizations
 - Medical Interpreter
 - Social Service Interpreter
 - Employee/LAPL
